<u>PE</u>

# <u>Tapestry</u>

Please remember to check tapestry at least every week. There will be news of your children's learning and also information about what is happening in class. We also

# **Reading and Phonics**

We are continuing with our phonics scheme this term - 'Little Wandle Letters and Sounds'. Keep an eye on tapestry for more information about it and for resources such as sound cards that you can purchase and use at home to support learning.

### <u>Trips</u>

There will hopefully be a trip to Cromer Library this term, to listen to some dragon stories and have a browse of the books. There will also be a walk around the village to spot signs of the seasons changing.

### <u>Homework</u>

During the term, your child will bring home some phonics work that reflects the work they have done in school that week. It is very beneficial for your child to reinforce and share what they have learned in school that week. Therefore it would be great if you could set aside a few minutes to go through these with your child when they come home.
