This half term, we will be focussing on Non-chronological reports and posters. We will be learning about the features of a non-chronological report and writing our own report about Greek tourism. We will make posters using persuasive language to encourage people to visit Greece.	This half term, we will be continuing to add and subtract numbers with up to three and four digits, using the more formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction. We will then move onto multiplication and division.	States of matter In this unit we will compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gasses. We will observe what happens to materials when they are heated and cooled and identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.	Our RE enquiry question is: How do Hindu's make sense of the world? In PSHE our topic is Think Positive and we are building on what the children have already learnt about feelings, both comfortable and uncomfortable and how our attitude towards life can affect our mental health.
PE & Music PE will continue to be on Mondays for Year 4 & 5 and your child can come to school in their PE kit. This half term we will be focussing on Yoga. In music, we will continue having Eve every Thursday for a music lesson. We will also be learning about symmetrical patterns in songs.	Computing This half term in Computing we will be looking at digital art and using a website called PixelArt.com. The children will taking on various projects including drawing Greek Landscapes and making Christmas Wrapping paper.	History & Geography This half term we will have a Geography focus. We will be learning all about Europe with a focus on Greece. We will be using maps and atlases to locate mountains, rivers, states and cities. We will learn how to describe the geographical features and compare Athens with Norwich.	Art & Design & Technology This half term will have an D & T focus and we are going to make Greek Food and design our own recipe. They will be learning how to prepare different foods and to cook hygienically.
